Dr. García y Griego teaches courses on Post-revolutionary Mexico, New Mexico history since 1848, U.S. Politics since 1787, and international migration and U.S. policy since 1820. His research is multidisciplinary, and includes the fields of Latin American Studies, Chicano/a Studies, demography, ethnic politics, and public policy. A native of New Mexico, Dr. García has taught at El Colegio de México (Centro de Estudios Internacionales), the University of California, Irvine (Department of Politics and Society), and directed the Center for Mexican American Studies (CMAS) at the University of Texas at Arlington. At UNM he directs the Southwest Hispanic Research Institute (SHRI) and is a member of the Latin American and Iberian Institute (LAI). Dr. García also is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Cañon de Carnué Land Grant, founded in 1763.
